Affirmative

Negative

I do not like	I don't like	. I don't like playing video games.
You do not like	You don't like	. You don't like watching TV.
He does not like	He doesn't like	. He doesn't like running.
She does not like	She doesn't like	. She doesn't like writing letters.
It does not like	It doesn't like	. It doesn't like jumping.
We do not like	We don't like	. We don't like singing.
You do not like	You don't like	. You don't like reading comics.
They do not like	They don't like	. They don't like painting.

Do I like...?	Yes, I do.	No, I don't.	. Do I like going to school?
